1. WHO CAN PLAY IN THE PRO-AM?

2. HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR THE TOURNAMENT?

The captain must sign up first to establish the team, followed by the sign up of the players

The entry fee is: \$250 - Before Nov. 30
\$299 - After Nov. 30

4. WILL I RECEIVE A TAX RECEIPT?

No, you will receive great value for your nominal registration fee of \$250 or \$299

5. HOW MUCH DOES MY TEAM NEED TO RAISE?

In total teams must raise \$25,000
